



A BISHOP'S VESTMENTS

mitre

Tall, pointed ceremonial head-dress worn by the Pope and Bishops.

alb

Simple tunic.

chasuble

Worn over the alb. Colours vary depending on liturgical season, feasts or other observances.

stole

Strip of linen adorned with crosses, worn under the chasuble.

At his ordination, a bishop receives the *crozier* (like a shepherd's staff) to symbolize his responsibility for the flock - the members of his Diocese/Archdiocese.

ring

Gold or silver band, often with a precious stone.
